We are very proud of our sixth form, and are ambitious for our students. The quality of both teaching and pastoral care is excellent, and our students leave school well prepared for their lives ahead, whether that be in higher education, employment, or discovering the world.

- There will be an open morning on Tuesday 10 March from 9.30 11.15 in school for you to come along and find out more about our post 16 provision. The morning will include meeting the sixth form team, speaking with current students, a tour of the school, and an opportunity to ask any questions you may have in a 1-2-1. All parents who have filled in the expression of interest form as mentioned above will receive an email in February 2026 to invite them to this event.

- 2. Passport or proof of ID and date of birth
