#### Year 11 Headline Information

- 243 students considered
- For the broader cohort the most popular destination was to remain at Ponteland High School in order to attend 6<sup>th</sup> Form. The most popular alternate route was to attend Newcastle College.
- The majority of students were able to advance to study Level 3 courses (77%) although for students who received pupil premium (62%) or who were classified as having SEN (31%) this was not so frequently the case. In most instances not having good GCSE qualifications in both English and Maths was a key factor in this. However, in a number of cases students opted to access Level 2 courses as the only route in to their preferred area to pursue.
- A significant trend emerged in the popularity of sports affiliated courses linked to local teams that offer routes to pursue a sport alongside a broader college route.
- Despite significant focus last year, a relatively small percentage of students accessed Apprenticeship routes.
