



Key Learning		Pre-Exposure Tasks	Linked Fiction
Autumn 1	Chez Moi Learn to talk about home life and families in French. Learn vocabulary to describe where you live and what you like doing at home, who you get on with at home, what you are allowed to do, and what you need to do at home (e.g. chores, access technology). Study 'Ma Vie de Courgette,' a short French film which examines family relationships and social issues. Consolidate key structures from previous learning, and build on grammar learning reflexive verbs and more complex vocabulary. Learn how to use modal verbs and complex verbs of obligation.	Write 20 sentences in French using the language you learned in year 7 or 8. Revisit the parts of the verb 'to have', and the verb 'to be'. Spring 1	Celebrations Talk about Christmas and birthday celebrations, as well as other common celebrations in francophone families – e.g. Eid. Explore celebrations, such as Bastille day and Mardi Gras and compare these to British customs/traditions. Develop an understanding of past and future tenses and be able to use these in general conversation to talk about celebrating. Develop listening, reading, and production skills using a variety of roleplay situations such as at the doctor's, shopping, and conversations in a restaurant. Summer 1	Healthy Living Consolidate knowledge of language to describe illnesses. Explore how to talk about lifestyles and whether you are healthy or unhealthy, including discussing the dangers of smoking, drinking, and unhealthy diets. Learn language to talk about ideal relationships and what makes a good partner. Learn how to talk about what they should/should not do to stay healthy using the conditional tense and modal verbs. For cultural study, learn about the French Occupation during WW2, and practise applying the grammar learned this year to discuss this topic in French.
